## **REPORT IT IMMEDIATELY**

Algal blooms block sunlight killing plants that play a vital role in the river's ecology. reducing oxygen in water at night killing salmon and brown trout. They are caused by a number of factors, including phosphate. The upper river Wye is now a significant source, one tributary in Powys hosting an extra ten million chickens producing massive amounts of phosphates from their manures. Phosphate in the Wye from agriculture has doubled in the past six years. The river is failing permitted levels of phosphate under the EU Habitats Directive.
